The many parks, restaurants and an almost entirely car-free historical centre make it the perfect place to relax, shop, taste culinary specialties and visit the countless cultural highlights.

The youth hostel

The youth hostel is located in the Pfaffenthal district of Luxembourg City, right in between the modern Kirchberg and Luxembourg's historical centre with its countless bars, cafes, shops, restaurants and museums. There is perhaps no better place in the city for dynamic and adventurous accommodation that aims at bringing people from all over the world together. Modern dorms, fully equipped conference rooms, children's birthday parties and a restaurant that offers diverse menus with local and regional products, are just a few of the things on offer for our guests of any age group.

Facilities

- ▶ 240 beds spread over 50 dorms:
 - 28 x 4 beds en-suite (2 rooms are accessible for wheelchairs);
 - 2 x 4 beds with shower; 15 x 6 beds, showers and toilets on the corridor;
 - 5 x 6 beds en-suite
- ▶ In-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' with a wide selection of dishes, buffets and barbecues
- ▶ Cafeteria
- ▶ 1 common room with library, pool table and TV
- ▶ 1 fully equipped conference room
- ▶ 2 assembly rooms
- ▶ Bicycle shelter and repair materials
- ▶ Terrace overlooking the old town
- ▶ Garden with playground
- ▶ Table tennis

Recreation

Getting to know this incredibly diverse city will take longer than people would expect: Whether you want to walk along the fortifications, explore the caves of the UNESCO World Heritage Bock casemates, visit the museums and art galleries, go shopping or discover the nightlife of the capital – built in 963, Luxembourg City will have what you're looking for regardless of your age.

Getting there

Due to its fabulous location, the historical city centre is within a few minutes walking distance from the youth hostel. The city centre, central station and airport are easily reachable by public transport. The nearest bus stop to the youth hostel is called 'Plateau Altmunster'. Parking spaces for cars, motorcycles and buses are available free of charge on the premises of the youth hostel. A shuttle service is available on request.
