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Situated on the banks of the river Sure, Echternach is the oldest city in Luxembourg. Alongside its charming, medieval character, it is also the principal town of Luxembourg's picturesque Little Switzerland, making it the ideal starting point for anyone eager to discover the scenic region known for its many forests, rivers and impressive rock formations. Most of all, however, Echternach is famous for its Dancing Procession held on Whit Tuesday – an ancient tradition that has since been added to the UNESCO List of Intangible Cultural Heritage.

## The youth hostel

Adventure and team spirit all year round at the sports hostel on the shores of Echternach Lake! A fully-equipped gymnasium, a 14 metre high climbing wall, a bicycle/mountain bike rental outlet and a trampoline park make this youth hostel the perfect spot for anyone seeking activity and adventure. The modern rooms of this youth hostel are exclusively en-suite. Furthermore, our infrastructure is accessible for people with disabilities. As there is no age limit either, each and everyone is welcome here!

## Facilities

- ▶ 118 beds spread over 29 en-suite rooms: 2 x 2 beds (equipped for wheelchair access), 6 x 3 beds, 14 x 4 beds, 2 x 5 beds, 5 x 6 beds
- ▶ In-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' with a wide selection of dishes, buffets and barbecues
- ▶ Fully equipped gymnasium
- ▶ Indoor climbing wall with boulder area
- ▶ Bar overlooking the climbing wall
- ▶ 2 common rooms
- ▶ 2 fully-equipped conference rooms
- ▶ 1 assembly room
- ▶ Trampoline park including bungee trampoline
- ▶ Terrace overlooking the lake
- ▶ Bicycle shelter and repair materials
- ▶ Bicycle and mountain bike rental outlet

## Recreation

Echternach is rich in monuments, historical buildings and museums. Furthermore, there is a wide range of recreational and sporting activities available. Aside from the many offers by the local youth hostel, the city and artificial lake feature countless opportunities for hiking – such as the famous Mullerthal Trail – as well as cycling routes and mountain bike trails, swimming pools and much more!

## Getting there

Echternach is situated directly at the German border – 36 km away from Luxembourg City – and is easily reached from the capital by public transport. The bus stops 'Centre de secours' and 'Belle-Vue' (coming from the other direction) as well as the charming city centre of Echternach are within walking distance of the youth hostel.
