Discover the stunning beauty and diversity of the Moselle region, right on the border with France and Germany! Remerschen belongs to the municipality of Schengen, known throughout the world for the famous agreement signed here in 1985. Above all, however, tourists flock to the region in order to visit the countless wineries and picturesque villages lined up along the banks of the Moselle River.

The youth hostel

Combining modern architecture with historic charm, the youth hostel has some of its dorms located in a recently constructed building while others are in a renovated convent. 28 modern rooms offer a lovely view over the nature reserve and bathing pond. Two cosy dorms in the attic of the convent are ideal for school groups or scouts, among others. Furthermore, an in-house restaurant with a team of experienced chefs will take excellent care of your culinary desires – maybe in combination with one of the many local wines? The youth hostel has no age restrictions and is open to both the young and young at heart.

Facilities

Recreation

A large, artificial lake offers a wide range of sporting activities while the countless hiking trails and cycling paths in the region guarantee a relaxing stay for the whole family. The vicinal nature reserve 'Haff Réimech' and its visiting centre 'Biodiversum' are an ideal place for guests to witness an undisturbed environment that is home to an extraordinary flora and fauna. Furthermore, there is much to explore and see across the borders too, such as the Roman Villa in Germany's Perl-Borg or Malbrouck Castle in nearby France.

Getting there

Remerschen is located right at the border triangle formed by Germany, France and Luxembourg. The youth hostel can be reached by public transport to the bus stop 'Aal Schoul' and detailed bus schedules can be found on the website of Luxembourg's mobility centre: www.mobiliteit.lu. For guests arriving by car, the youth hostel is best reached by motorways (A13/A8) between Luxembourg and Saarbrücken, exiting at Schengen. Free parking spaces are available in close proximity to the youth hostel.
