Exciting discoveries are to be made in the picturesque, medieval city of Vianden with its famous castle and archaic, cobblestoned roads! With its hilly landscape along the banks of the river Our, Vianden is a truly beautiful and unique city. The majestic castle – one of the largest in Europe – with its fortifications and watchtowers overlooks the city from the top of a hill. The medieval festival held in August is the highlight of the year and attracts visitors from all over the world.

## The youth hostel

The youth hostel is situated in a traditional manor in the upper part of the city and offers a breathtaking view over the famous castle, located just a stone's throw away. Although not all of the dorms overlook the castle, the youth hostel sits in the perfect spot for tours of the castle and activities revolving around the medieval character of the city. On request, the chefs of the youth hostel can even prepare a medieval menu for groups. As there is no age restriction for guests, the youth hostel is open to anyone eager to be enchanted by the romantic, medieval charm of the city.

## Facilities

- ▶ 66 beds spread over 10 rooms, showers and toilets on the corridor:  
2 x 2 beds, 2 x 3 beds, 1 x 6 beds,  
2 x 8 beds, 1 x 10 beds, 2 x 12 beds
- ▶ In-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' with a wide selection of dishes, buffets and barbecues
- ▶ 1 small meeting room
- ▶ Bicycle shelter and repair materials

## Recreation

Be it by bicycle, on foot, or on one of the numerous mountain bike trails – Vianden is rich in opportunities to explore the beautiful nature of the Our valley. The museums and castle tell us much about the astonishing history of the city. It's not for no reason that the famous writer Victor Hugo – to whom the city has dedicated a museum – fell in love with Vianden during his many visits, eventually even moving there. Using the chairlift, visitors furthermore have the opportunity to view the picturesque city from a unique perspective. Why not pay a visit to the adventure park or cool off in the open air swimming pool?

## Getting there

Vianden is located on the German border, 48 km from Luxembourg City, and can be reached by public transportation. The bus stop is called 'Vianden Bréck' and connects Vianden to the nearby towns of Clervaux and Ettelbruck.
