⚠ The youth hostel

The new youth hostel is situated right by the train station of Luxembourg's second-largest city. A total of 122 beds in 36 modern ensuites with two to five beds are available to our guests. A fully equipped conference room as well as four meeting facilities furthermore make the hostel ideal for seminars, workshops and conferences. Children's birthday parties and a wide range of leisure activities for groups can also be booked.

Our spacious on-site restaurant offers local and regional specialities, a daily menu and 'à la carte' options. All areas of the youth hostel are accessible for wheelchairs.

Leisure

Esch/Alzette is the heart of Southern Luxembourg, the so-called Minette region. Long before the Grand Duchy became a global player in the financial sector and the European Union institutions were established, the region was known throughout Europe for iron ore exploitation and processing. While the Minette's industrial heritage remains omnipresent, Esch and its modern Belval district have become popular for students and concertgoers. Several music venues, including the country's largest – the Rockhal – are found here. Take a tour of the blast furnaces of Belval, visit the national mining museums in Rumelange and Ellergronn or take a ride on the authentic steam train to discover the region's fascinating culture. The large Galgenberg Park directly behind the youth hostel is perfect to relax and its petting zoo 'Déierepark Esch' is a real highlight for children in particular. The country's South is also very popular with mountain bikers as a series of exciting trails criss-cross the region.
