

Hollenfels is located in the legendary Valley of the Seven Castles and harbors many secrets which are yet to be revealed. There is nowhere else besides this village where you can discover this many castles and forts. The valley with the castles of Mersch, Schoenfels, Ansembourg and Koerich and the forts of Ansembourg, Septfontaines and Hollenfels – located opposite the youth hostel - is one of the most touristic highlights of the country.

The youth hostel

The youth hostel is located opposite the fort of Hollenfels with its 40 m high keep. 86 beds are disposed in 17 rooms with one to ten beds. Group activities and children's birthdays are available on request. Two common rooms and one craft room are at the guests' disposal. As the youth hostel is located on the mounds of the valley of the Eisch, why not arrive by e-bike and use the hostel's charging station. The in-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' serves menus as well as fresh and regional specialties on a daily basis upon reservation. When the sun shines, you can relax on the terrace with its view of the castle.

A Leisure

If you'd like to enjoy your holiday in the heart of the country, the so-called 'Guttland' region, why not stay in the charming village Hollenfels? This village lies in the Valley of the Seven Castles, surrounded by forts, castles, forests and rivers and can be discovered on foot or by bike. Hollenfels is characterised by its fort, located on the promontory of a rock ledge overviewing the valley of the Eisch just opposite the youth hostel. A stone bridge connects the hostel to the fort. But the region has more to offer than just forts and castles. The adventure farm – a sheep farm in Tuntange – as well as the visitor centre of the Luxlait farmer's cooperative in Roost called 'Vitarium' are open to the public. If you prefer more action, you can also spend your day at the high rope course Steinfort Adventure or visit the grottos of the Mamerlayen. Those who like bathing will enjoy the swimming pool 'Krounebierg' in Mersch. More information about the activities: www.visitguttland.lu

Q Facilities

- A total of 86 beds and 17 rooms with showers on the ground floor and toilets on the respective floors:

 - 2 rooms x 8 beds;

Q Getting there

Hollenfels can be reached by car in 30 minutes from the city centre. On weekdays, a bus line connects the village to the capital city as well as Mersch. The bus stop 'Hollenfels, Schoul' is located 200 metres from the youth hostel. If you travel by train from the city centre, get off at Mersch and take the bus line 431 (Mersch-Ansembourg/Marienthal) or the bus 435 (Mersch-Eischen) to the stop 'Hollenfels, Schoul'. The bus line 270 (Luxembourg-Tuntange-Hollenfels-Marienthal) also stops in Hollenfels. More information or timetables for buses to/from the bus stop 'Hollenfels, Schoul': www.mobiliteit.lu
