

Larochette, also referred to as 'Fels', was named after the rock, on top of which the castle was built. The ruins of this castle still overlook the valley of the White Ernz. Not only the castle, but also the historic and picturesque market place, the narrow and ancient alleys, the old monuments and the melting pot of different nationalities turn Larochette into a magical place.

# **(A)** The youth hostel

The youth hostel is located in a spacious park with small bungalows. rest areas and a direct connection to the hiking trails of the region. 78 beds are disposed in 14 double rooms, seven bungalows with five beds each and one chalet with 15 beds. Activities for groups as well as children's birthdays are available on request. A fully equipped conference room as well as a common room are at the guests' disposal. The in-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' serves daily menus as well as local and seasonal specialties 'à la carte' upon request.

## **Leisure**

Village, forest, castle, river - this is a short but concise description of Larochette. With its castle ruins, looking over the valley of the White Ernz and the picturesque market place, Larochette is the perfect place for a retreat worth the trip. Even Victor Hugo visited this small village several times during his lifetime. Hiking, cycling, mountain biking or just relaxing are only a few of the numerous activities possible in this village. Why not visit the park and play a game of Frisbee golf? The equipment can be rented at the youth hostel. The castle of Larochette and the textile museum are also worth a visit. During summer, the swimming pool at the camping Birkelt is the place to be. The youth hostel Larochette is located in the Mullerthal region - Luxembourg's Little Switzerland, in the middle of one of the most beautiful regions of Luxembourg. # Getting there

Larochette is located only 30 minutes by car from Luxembourg-City. Public bus lines connect Larochette to Luxembourg-City, Mersch, Ettelbruck, Diekirch and Echternach. The bus stop 'Larochette, Leedebach' is located on the main street in Larochette, 100 m from the youth hostel. You can also take the train from Luxembourg-City to Ettelbruck and continue on the bus 507 (Diekirch/Ettelbruck-Grevenmacher) to the bus stop 'Larochette, Leedebach'. The following bus lines also stop in Larochette: 100 (Luxembourg-Larochette-Diekirch), 409 (Mersch-Larochette-Stegen), 504 (Ettelbruck-Haller), 848 (Echternach-Colmar/Usines).
