YOUTH HOSTEL LUXENB CORG

Castle ruins and the European Court of Justice, banks and art museums, cosmopolitanism and traditional markets – contrasts enliven the cityscape of the capital of Luxembourg. Its youth hostel is located at the edge of the UNESCO zone below the bock promontory.

▲ The youth hostel

The modern, affordable and largest youth hostel of the country lies in the heart of the Pfaffenthal district between the historic old town and the modern Kirchberg Plateau. 240 beds are disposed in 50 rooms with four to six beds. Group activities and children's birthdays are available on request. The large conference hall and two meetings rooms of the youth hostel are the perfect place of encounter for meetings and events. Varied coffee breaks as well as catering complete the offer of the youth hostel. In the in-house restaurant 'Melting Pot', you may savour local as well as seasonal dishes or order 'à la carte'. The lovely terrace with its panoramic view of the old town is the perfect place for a meal or beverage. The youth hostel is accessible for wheel chairs.

A Leisure

If you want to get to know the capital city with all of its facets, you'll definitely need some time. The city boasts numerous circular walks such as the Goethe, Vauban or Wenzel walk through the old town and over the fortress walls. The many museums, art galleries and architectural masterpieces furthermore make the capital the perfect place for cultural excursions. The official residency of the Grand-Duke is also a must-see. The city's youth hostel is located in the Pfaffenthal district of the capital, one of the oldest parts of town. Just a few minutes' walk from the UNESCO World Heritage *Bock Casemates* and remains of the fortress walls, it's the perfect starting point for history buffs. An interesting highlight in the Pfaffenthal is the 'virtual reality'-tour in the time travel bus (2 km). More information about the activities: www.luxembourg-city.com

Getting there

The youth hostel is located at the foot of the historic city centre in Pfaffenthal. The buses 9 (Gare, Neudorf, Cents-Waasertuerm) and 14 (Gare-Cents, Waassertuerm) stop at 'Plateau Altmunster'. If you arrive by plane, take the bus 29 to the bus stop 'Cents-Waassertuerm' and then the lines 9 or 14 to the 'Plateau Altmunster'. Those arriving by train can get off at the central station and take the bus to 'Plateau Altmunster' or get off at the train station 'Pôle Européen' at Pfaffenthal and walk to the youth hostel (800 m). If you'd rather take the bus than walk, you may take the line 23 and get off at 'Pfaffenthal-Vauban'.
