Diverse discoveries as well as unforgettable adventures are waiting for you at the border triangle on the Moselle. Remerschen is located in the municipality of Schengen, well-known throughout Europe because of the Schengen agreements. But the true highlights of the Moselle are the charming villages with its numerous wine cellars.

⚠ The youth hostel

Modern architecture and historical charm become one as part of the youth hostel is located in a renovated cloister and another part in a newly-build building. 114 beds are disposed in 28 modern rooms with one to five beds, ensuite bathrooms and a balcony. Two cosy dormitories with 36 beds are located on the top floor of the cloister and await school classes as well as scouts. Group activities and children's birthdays are available on request. A large conference room as well as two meeting rooms are also available. The inhouse restaurant 'Melting Pot' serves menus and fresh and regional specialties on a daily basis. During summer, the terrace with a view of the pond invites you to linger. The main building is accessible for wheel chairs.

& Leisure

There is nowhere else where you can get as close to Europe as in Remerschen. The charming winemaking village is part of the municipality of Schengen, known all over the World for the agreements signed here in 1985. The European museum on the river promenade is dedicated to this milestone in European unity. As Remerschen is located in the heart of the border triangle of Luxembourg, Germany and France, divided only by the Moselle, adventures without borders are a must. If you visit France, the beautiful castle of Malbrouck is a must see. If you'd rather spend some time in Germany, you should visit Perl and its roman Villa Borg. If you want to explore the Moselle region, why not do it on foot, by bike or by boat. Remerschen is also well-known for its nature reserve 'Haff Réimech' and its significant biodiversity. Worth a detour is also the interactive museum 'Biodiversum'. After its visit, you can enjoy a day at the bathing ponds, located opposite the museum. Wine aficionados should definitely visit some wine producers, located along the Moselle. More information about the activities:

Q Getting there

You can reach Remerschen by car in 30 minutes from the capital city. The bus stop 'Remerschen, Al Schoul' is located near the youth hostel. The following bus lines also stop here: 176 (Luxembourg-Remich), 184 (Remich-Moutfort-Kirchberg), 185 (Mondorf-Schengen-Remich) and 453 (Schengen-Grevenmacher).
